

Install certificate for Internet Explorer or Chrome

- Save certificate
- Import certificate



The short manual describes how to store a SWAN client certificate on your computer and install it in the browser.

The client certificate is issued by the SSC certification authority and provided to the new SWAN user via email.

As the certificate is validated on every login to SWAN, it is recommended to store the certificate in a secure directory on your computer.

The key password of the certificate, which has to be entered during the installation, is sent to you in a separate email.

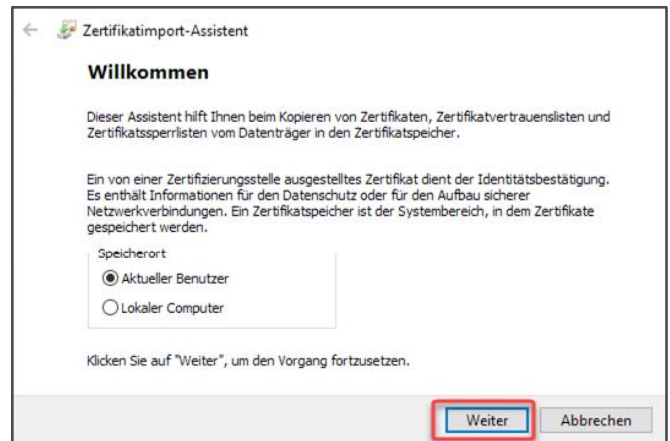

Save Client Certificate

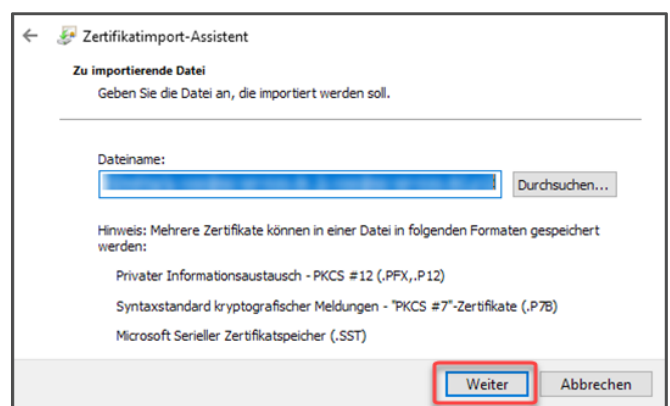
- Save the client certificate that you have received via email into a secure directory.

Start Certificate Import Wizard

- Start Windows Explorer and navigate to the directory where the client certificate is stored.
- Double click on the client certificate.
 - ⇒ The Certificate Import Wizard is displayed.

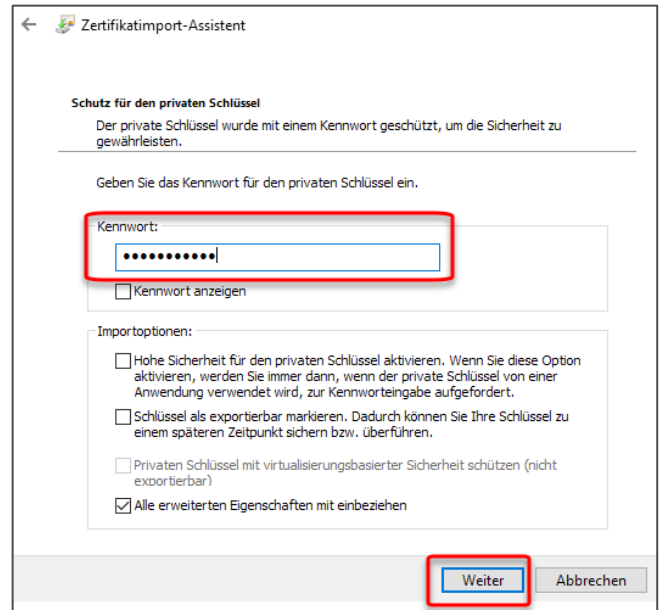


- Click on **Next**.
 - ⇒ The window for importing the file is displayed.
 - ⇒ The client certificate is already entered in the field **File name**.
- Click on **Next**.



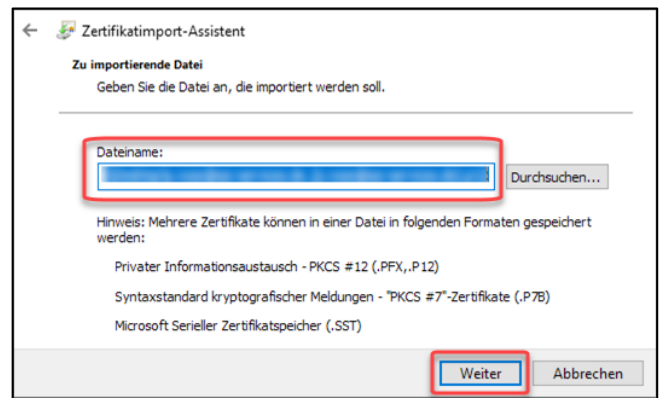
Enter Certificate Key Password

- Enter the certificate key password into the field **Password**.
- Click on **Next**.



Select Certificate Store

- Let Windows select the store for the client certificate automatically. Don't change the presetting (Automatically select the certificate store).
- Click on **Next**.



Complete Certificate Import

- Click on **Finish**.
 - ⇒ The certificate is imported into the Browser.
- Click on **OK**.
